On February 1, 2021, the Central Shift Office is changing its real-time notifications of COVID-19 facility restrictions and disinfections. The change is necessary to maintain a heightened sense of awareness of operational Shift Office Event Notifications (SOEN).

There is no change to COVID-19 response actions. COVID-19 facility restrictions and disinfections are driven by entry into Standing Order SO-OPS-20-001, "Response to Notification of COVID-19 Test," and per Emergency Operations Center (EOC) direction, not guidance provided within TF-AOP-001. Beginning February 1, 2021, relocation of personnel due to COVID-19 will no longer be tied to abnormal operating procedure TF-AOP-001.

The commitment to communicate real time facility restrictions remains. A new notification has been created within SOEN for those personnel who wish to be notified when a facility is impacted by COVID-19. If you wish to receive COVID-19 restriction and disinfection notifications via SOEN, you will need to send an email request to ^SOEN Administration <Shift_Office_Event_Notification@rl.gov>. Please indicate in the email if you wish to receive COVID-19 restriction and disinfection notifications in addition to the operational SOEN notifications you may already receive, or if you wish to receive COVID-19 notifications only.
